



Terms of Participation

REGISTRATION

Children admitted to the Summer Camp are aged from 6 years old (those who will be attending 1st Grade in September) to 13 years old (those who will be attending 8th Grade Gymnasium).

For the participation of children in the Summer Camp, registration through our website www.dcac.gr (see Online Registration – Register - Summer Camp) is required.

Fees must be paid for the registration to be completed.

There is a limited number of available positions at the Summer Camp and they can only be booked by making the payment.

If you wish to use the bus service, you must also register for every week you plan to use it.

Cancellations will be accepted up to 10 days prior to the corresponding week and 80% of the deposited amount will be refunded. After this time, there will be no refunds.

In case you wish to extend your participation to more weeks than you had initially registered for, you will have to do it through the website www.dcac.gr and your profile that was created during your online registration to the Summer Camp, provided that there are available positions.

The online application should be submitted, at the latest, by Friday noon (12:00) of the week before the one that you wish to participate in.

Each child will take part in the activities of the program that have been selected through the online application.

The activities are carried out with a certain number of participants and if the number has been reached, another activity will have to be chosen. The recreational hour activities are not declared during the online registration. For the climbing activity, parental consent in written form is required.

The use of mobile phones, skateboards, roller skates and electronic games is not permitted.

In the case that the participants do not abide by the rules and regulations of the school, and display improper conduct, the Summer Camp has the right to remove them from the program without a refund.

CHANGE OF ACTIVITY

If there is a serious reason, changing an activity is accepted for the upcoming week(s) only, provided there are available positions. Changes are made only through the website www.dcac.gr and the profile that you had created during the registration, up to Friday noon (12:00) of the week before the one that you wish to make the change.

MEDICAL FORM

For the participation of your child in the activities, it is necessary that the Summer Camp Medical Report Form – completed by the parent/guardian (section A), and completed & signed by the Pediatrician (Section B) - be submitted in your profile that was created during your online registration. Until the submission of the Medical Report Form, participation will not be permitted.

For any serious medical incident while the children are at the Summer Camp, the Infirmary immediately notifies the parents at the phone numbers they have submitted on the participation Application Form.

ARRIVAL-DEPARTURE

The children must enter and exit the facilities of the Summer Camp at the predetermined time, always accompanied by the parent/legal guardian for the smooth operation of the program.

Children must always have their Summer Camp ID card, which is issued to them on the first day, on them. In the case that it gets lost, there is an additional cost to issue a new one.

BUS SERVICE

In the case that the student uses the bus, the escort is obliged to be with the child at the agreed bus stop in the morning. Otherwise, it is the escort's responsibility to bring the child to the Summer Camp.

Respectively, in the afternoon, the escort is obliged to be at the agreed bus stop at the given time so as to collect the child.

Only individuals who have been declared as escorts at the Transportation Office of the Summer Camp can collect the child.

In the case that no one is at the bus stop to collect the child, the child remains on the bus and returns to the College, following the completion of the bus route, and is collected by the parent/legal guardian from there.

You are kindly requested to be at the bus stop earlier than the time indicated on the bus route, as the buses cannot be delayed.

The time on the bus routes is indicative and depends on the traffic.

The bus stops and the bus routes are formed based on time efficiency, so that the children remain on the bus the least possible time.

The routes and stops require minimum participation in order to run.

The communication with the parents is held through e-mail or mobile phone.

The use of morning only or afternoon only bus route is charged at 75% of the regular cost for bus service.

The Deree College Athletic Club maintains the right to modify the bus routes, if this is deemed necessary.
